1. **Apologies**

Apologies were received from Cllr Corbett

2. **Minutes of the meeting of 29/3/17**

RESOLVED: To accept the Minutes of the meeting of 29/3/17

3. **Matters arising from the last minutes**

Donors' Plaque: Martyn Collinson reported that there had been no further progress on this issue in the absence of John Caulcutt.

Ground levelling: Playdale have consistently refused to accept responsibility for the uneven ground underneath the swings, and YTC had agreed to proceed with the quote from Brighstone Landscaping.

Ground Clearance by Pavilion: 14/5/17 was agreed as the next date for clearing the ground around the Pavilion. Discussion took place about restricting access to the Pavilion, and fencing it off was considered to prevent unauthorised access.

The Clerk undertook to arrange the purchase of a second keyed padlock for the northern Rec entrance gate.

Peter Scott reported that he had obtained an estimate for the sign on the northern gate of £75, including VAT and installation.

It was RESOLVED to proceed with the quote from Island Roads for street signage, which Yarmouth Town Trust will fund.

4. **Play area fencing, signage, plaques, etc.**

The Clerk confirmed that Peter Scott and Martyn Collinson had been formally co-opted to the Recreation Ground Committee.

5. Replacement of Pavilion

Discussions took place about funding for the Pavilion refurbishment, and Martyn Collinson reported that a marketeer had been engaged to assist with this activity.
