1. **Apologies**

3. **Matters arising from the last minutes**

**Donors' Plaque:** The order for the plaque had been placed with A J Wells.

**Other plaques:** Cllr Cronin had identified a position on the Orbiter for an adhesive plaque, though it was acknowledged that it could be subject to wear by feet, in spite of being in a spot where users would not normally stand.

**Ground levelling:** Brighstone Landscaping has now completed this work, but it was resolved to request full Council to consider fencing off the seeded area to allow the grass to grow.

**New padlock:** Cllr Cronin and the Clerk will visit Newport after the meeting to arrange the purchase of a second keyed padlock for the northern Rec entrance gate.

4. **Play area fencing, signage, plaques, etc.**

There were no further items to discuss

5. **Replacement of Pavilion**

Martyn Collinson reported that he will again apply to YHC for a grant for the renovation of the Pavilion, emphasising the value of the project to both town and harbour.

It was felt that consideration will need to be given to the construction of the veranda when renovation begins.
