MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF YARMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL HELD AT YARMOUTH TOWN HALL ON WEDNESDAY 6TH SEPTEMBER 2017.

1. **Apologies**

Apologies were received from Peter Scott

2. **Minutes of the meeting of 28/6/17**

RESOLVED: To accept the Minutes of the meeting of 28/6/17

3. **Matters arising from the last minutes**

Fencing: Now completed

Other plaques: Cllr Cronin has produced a design for the Orbiter adhesive plaque. Martyn Collinson will present this to the next meeting of Yarmouth Town Trust on 11/9/17.

Ground levelling: This seems to be satisfactory, and the new grass is growing well. Consideration will be given to artificial grass for the remaining area.

Gate security: A bracket needs to be welded to the gate to prevent it being lifted off its hinges. RESOLVED: The Clerk will send an email to Y&CFC to inform that a maximum of 2 cars will be allowed access to the Recreation Ground for practices and games, and one of the Club's officers will be given a key to the padlock.

4. **Play area fencing, signage, plaques, etc.**

There were no further items to discuss

5. **Replacement of Pavilion**

Martyn Collinson reported that he has requested a grant of £10K from Yarmouth Harbour Commissioners for the renovation of the Pavilion. He will also approach the Herapath-Shenton Trust for a grant towards the veranda, for which two quotes will be required; Roger Hanley was suggested for one.

Cllr Corbett suggested that a floor plan was required, and Martyn Collinson agreed to obtain this from Yarmouth & Calbourne football Club, along with details of the roof and canopy designs. He reported that Y&CFC have embarked on a series of fundraising measures including a sponsored sky dive, fetes, and 'sponsor a plank', and he will also suggest a letter box drop in Yarmouth (to be approved by YTT). A half-page advertisement in the RSYC magazine was also suggested. Martyn will also ask Y&CFC would be prepared to drop the reference to 'Calbourne' in their title.

Cllr Cronin brought the Committee's attention to a pile of rubble which had been left by the side of the Pavilion by Y&CFC, which local youths are using to vandalise the structure. Martyn Collinson agreed to raise this matter with Y&CFC.
