MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF YARMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL HELD AT CHOYD ON MONDAY 27TH MARCH 2018.

1. **Apologies**

2. **Minutes of the meeting of 5/3/18**

3. **Matters arising from the last minutes**

Board Rider: The Board Rider strap has now been received. Discussion took place as to whether to fit it (and risk its removal again) or sell it with the equipment.

Swings unit: As the original swings unit is no longer serviceable, a new unit would need to be purchased, and the Clerk circulated a copy of the HAGS catalogue, which contained suitable units at around £1.5K. It was considered that the unit for older children should be sited in the wild area, which would need to be cleared and flattened, and the Clerk was asked to obtain quotes from local contractors for this purpose.

Street Signage: It was reported that Island Roads had now installed the street signage.

4. **Play area fencing, signage, plaques, etc.**

There were no further issues for discussion

5. **Memorial Bench**

The Clerk confirmed that the site of the Coates-Evans memorial bench had been discussed at recent Yarmouth Town Council meetings, and the Committee confirmed its satisfaction with this project.

6. Replacement of Pavilion

Martyn reported that he had met with Y&CFC, and reported that the current opinion of the Club was to replace the existing building at a cost of £25K, and clarification on costs and size is awaited. Y&CFC will not be using the existing Pavilion after the current season, and the building will need to be secured, and disconnected from mains services.

It was confirmed that ownership of the Pavilion would be with Yarmouth Town Trust.
