Swing Unit: Cllr Cronin reported that he had arranged a meeting with Kompan, and the Clerk was asked to arrange a meeting with Sovereign Playgrounds. Quotations would also be sought for developing the meadow.

Board Rider: The Clerk reported that Freshwater PC had expressed interest in this unit, and a response had been sent indicating that transport could be arranged.

Play Area fencing: It was reported that the fencing needs treating, for which Roger Hanley has suitable preservative at £18 per litre. It was considered that the repainting could be carried out by volunteers, and these will be sought at the next monthly full council meeting. Cllr Allen has sufficient brushes to undertake this task.

Pavilion: Martyn Collinson reported that a new chairman and committee had been appointed for Yarmouth & Calbourne Football Club, and he will arrange a meeting with the new chairman. There was no further progress regarding the Pavilion.
