4. **Wild area: discussion of progress**

It was reported that, while some brambles remained to be cleared, most of the elm suckers had been removed and a significant area had been opened up for development.

The Herapath-Shenton Trust had been approached for funding the new equipment and remaining preparation, and authorisation was awaited.

Reference was made to a scheme, offered by Kompan for a 25% matching offer for equipment which carried a February deadline. Cllr Cronin reported that he had finally made contact with the Kompan engineer who had said he had prepared the estimate, though it had not yet been issued.

The Clerk was requested to seek a quote from Brighstone Landscaping for clearance of the remaining brambles and a dead elm tree, and to grass the area at their discretion.

It was proposed that an approach should be made to YOGOFF for funding the new equipment in return for naming the area with an allusion to 'Gaffers'.

5. **Replacement of Pavilion**

Martyn Collinson reported that Y&CFC had made no progress on the Pavilion or eastern netting structure. It was suggested that a planning application would be

needed should a replacement for the Pavilion go ahead. If Y&CFC have not secured the existing Pavilion by the expiry of their deadline, YTC will need to make arrangements to do so.
