MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF YARMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL HELD AT CHOYD ON THURSDAY 26th NOVEMBER 2019.

1. Apologies

Apologies were received from Peter Scott

2. Minutes of the meeting of 31/10/19 and extraordinary meeting of 7/11/19

RESOLVED: To accept the minutes of the meeting of 31/10/19 and

3. Matters arising from the last minutes

It was RESOLVED to recommend acceptance by full Council of the
Hillbans quote to undertake mole clearance.

No response had yet been received from the householder in Heytesbury
Close who had claimed that drainage water from the football pitch had
flooded her property.

The Clerk had not yet compiled a schedule of all grounds maintenance
tasks and their frequency which Yarmouth Town Council carries out and
liaise with the YTT Clerk with a view to combining them with a single
contractor, and will report on that at the next meeting.

4. Meadow: discussion of progress

Brighstone Landscaping has begun work on weed clearance and clearing
a path through to the cyclepath, but had been hampered by bad
weather.

5. Replacement of Pavilion

There was still some confusion about the terms of the lease with regard to the pavilion and hut footprint, as the lease ground plan was not sufficiently clear. It was believed that Peter Scott has a more definitive version, so further discussion was deferred until that was made available.

A quote had been received from SEE to terminate the electricity supply, but not what is required, only the meter is to be moved and Y&CFC will need to change the electricity contract over to YTC. It was recommended that the meter be moved to the hut, and Cllr Corbett undertook to consult his son to obtain an estimate to replace the roof and door of that structure. Martyn Collinson also undertook to obtain a quote from Jenners for the removal of the existing asbestos roof.

The Clerk was requested to contact Y&CFC to request the SEE and Southern Water accounts be transferred into YTC's name.
