### **3. Matters arising from the last minutes**

Martyn Collinson has emailed John Caulcutt re CCTV at the new pavilion when constructed.

The Clerk was asked to send an open letter to the properties adjoining the north-south ditch immediately before Brighstone Landscaping resume clearance work.

### **4. Pavilion & Hut**

There has been little progress made towards the new pavilion, and Martyn will make a proposal to YTT, detailing concern about vandalism, and will send a copy to the Clerk.

### **6. New Land drains/Additional facilities for Rec Ground**

Cllr Cronin reported that he had attended a meeting with Mayor Cowley and local contractor Mark Grieve. The land drains at the eastern side of the Rec were considered to be satisfactory, and an estimate of £7K had been given for the remaining area. Prior to any remedial work, the area would need to be rolled flat. A discussion occurred about the siting of the proposed Petanque pitch.

It was considered that the suggested junior goals would need to be fixed, as they would be too big for storage in the hut. Stadia Sports was nominated as a suitable

supplier. Cllr Cronin undertook to look through its website and recommend suitable goals and a basketball hoop.
