## MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF YARMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL HELD AT CHOYD ON 5/9/24

1. **Apologies**

Apologies were received from Rod Corbett

2. **Minutes of the meeting 11/7/24**

3. **Matters arising from the last minutes**

4. **Football Team**

Mark Holmes presented his revised suggestions for the proposed new Pavilion, which reduced the footprint to 10m X 10m and this was discussed and agreed by the Committee Members.

Mark gave details about Tesco grants for youth organisations which he will be pursuing.

He has spread 7 tons of sand onto part of the pitch to fill the cracks caused by recent dry weather, mostly on the eastern side of the pitch and has just mown the pitch.

5. **Play Area**

In accordance with the latest RoSPA report the following actions had been undertaken:

The Whirligig screws and springs had all been tightened, though there was still some movement.

The bearings of the roundabout had been inspected, but the foundations were found to be waterlogged. Cllrs Cronin and T Cowley will address this problem.

6. **Pedestrian Gates**

Cllr Cronin reported that the mesh and straps for the bottom of the gates had been ordered and delivery was awaited.

7. **Land Registry record for area between football pitch and cycle track**

The Clerk signed the lease variation and passed it across to Martyn.

Peter Scott reported that he had been unable to find any records identifying evidence of ownership by YTC of the wild area. Martyn agreed to undertake further enquiries.
